An MOU was signed this morning between Abu Dhabi's Department of Energy (DoE) and its sector companies and ZWEEC, to work towards an advanced World Class Capability Development Centre in the United Arab Emirates.

The signing ceremony, held at Singapore's national water agency, PUB's headquarters, was witnessed by His Excellency, Engineer Awaidha Murshed Al Marar, Chairman of the Department of Energy and Minister Masagos Zulkifli, Singapore's Minister for the Environment and Water Resources.

The MOU also paves the way for the pilot implementation of ZWEEC's fish activity monitoring and alert system – AquaTEC – for water security and water quality management in Abu Dhabi by Abu Dhabi Distribution Center. Parties agree to cooperate in areas of technology adoption, automation, water management and training through AquaTEC.
